



STUDY OF PROSPECT PARK ROADWAY USE

A roadway use study of Prospect Park is the first step in reimagining the park drive without vehicular traffic by restriping the road and replacing signals to prioritize park goers.

All park visitors, especially those who use the drive for exercise and micro mobility and seek more accessibility for activities including walking, jogging, and cycling.

Project Description

The purpose of the traffic study would be to determine what changes need to be made to the main drive now that the park is car-free. Reassignment of the newly reclaimed space will be assessed by a joint study completed by DOT and the Prospect Park Alliance. The study will look at restriping the roadway, adding more crosswalks, removing signals, and making a more accessible park for all users.
